AIDAN HAS BEEN INVITED TO PARTICIPATE IN MANY SWIM ALBERTA CAMPS FOR HIS ACHIEVEMENTS LAST SEASON, AT AGE 13, AIDAN WAS A 4X MEDALIST AT SWIM ALBERTA CHAMPIONSHIPS (BEST OF THE BEST IN AB). NOW THAT AIDAN HAS JUST TURNED 14, HE'S ABLE TO COMPETE AT A NATIONAL LEVEL (14 IS THE MIN AGE REQUIREMENT FOR MALES).
