Kudakwashe Simbi has participated in the Oilsands Rotary Music Festival for the past eleven years, and under the recent tutelage of Mr. and Mrs. Parr, has been accredited with many awards.

In 2017, the applicant was nominated for the Regional Municpality's Buffy Awards for the speeches she performed in the community. One such speech was her speech based on personal experiences of racism in her community. It was this speech that led to her qualifying for provincials that year, where she placed second. Following that she wrote a speech for International Women's Day, in which she performed at an event sponsored by Rehoboth Alliance. Kudakwashe also took the Royal Conservatory of Music of Toronto's Drama exams atn in her practical received 98%. As a result of her hard work and high mark, she was awarded with an award sponsored by Mayor Don Scott.

In 2019, Kudakwashe performed at the Rehoboth Black History Month Gala. She performed a speech from a previous event and added a poem "On the Pulse of the Morning" by Maya Angelou.

Aside from Kudakwashe's performances, she wanted to have a voice in her community so she applied and successfullly joined the Mayor's Advisory Council On Youth, specifially the Arts and Culture Committee.

Kudakwashe was also an active part of her school's performing community, starring as Mary Poppins in the 2019 school musical. In addition, she performed in the Holy Trinity High School's Elite Choir, an auditoned choir, which also was recommended to the Alberta Provincial Festival.

In order to qualify for the Alberta Excellence Class at the Alberta Provincial Festival, Kudakwashe was required to enter the Alberta Excellence Speech Solo class in the Oilsands Rotary Music Festivel, performing 6 selections of different styles of poetry, monologues, and mime. As a result of her excellent performance in this class, Kudakwashe was recommended to the Alberta Provincial Festival.
