Volleyball Alberta has the follwoing Identification Program/Pathway that Riley had to complete in order to be selected to the competition team:

- 1. Club Coaches provide athlete recommendations to Volleyball Alberta. (January)
- 2. Recommended athletes are invited to do the physical testing; conducted testing includes weight, height, standing reach, wingspan, grip strength, vertical jump (block, spike), T-test. Team Alberta Coaches evaluate the athlete recommendations and testing results. (February)
- Approximately 60 male athletes are extended an offer to attend an ID camp. (March)
- Team Alberta Coaches evaluate the athletes at the ID camp. (March)
- Team Alberta Coaches also evaluate the athletes in the Premier Season. (February April)
- 6. Team Alberta Coaches invite a maximum of 40 male athletes to attend the Team Alberta Training Centre in July.
- 7. Athletes attending the Training Centre have 5 days of training with Alberta's top coaches and high performance staff. (July)
- 8. From the training period, two teams of 12 athletes are selected to represent Alberta at Canada Cup. (July)

Riley was selected to 16U Boys Team Alberta Blue provincial team.

The Canada Cup event (https://volleyball.ca/en/competitions/2019-canada-cup-indoor) brought together Canada's next generation of high-performance athletes to compete for their home province/territory in a true national championship. The event featured over 40 teams, including both male and female athletes, in two divisions (18U & 16U) and represented 9 provinces and territories. The Canada Cup tournament was hosted by Volleyball Canada in Halifax, Nova Scotia at Dalhousie University. Team Alberta Blue (Riley's team) won the Division 2 category.
