The Northern Trailblazers Elite program offers a full train-to-compete experience for athletes. The season runs from September 2019 to July 2020, players are expected to attend 4 weekly team training events to prepare for competitions. All competitions this season are out of town mostly in Edmonton some may be in Calgary.
Team Events (5 hours of team events a week)
Elite players will have 4 team events during the week this season. Each event is an important part of building a better basketball player.
Game Day (1 hour) - Elite players will have 1 live competition period each week where they will compete against each other. Game days will fall on Monday's.
Strength and Conditioning (1 hour) - Helping our athletes improve physically throughout the season is important to us. This season we will be implementing a strength and conditioning program to help improve performance. Sunday's will be our strength and conditioning day for elite players.
Skill Development (1 hour) - 60 minutes of the week is specifically dedicated improving basketball specific skills. (shooting, dribbling, ball control, etc.). Skill development sessions will be held on Thursdays.

Practice (2 hours) - Practices will focus on team concepts and improving basketball awareness. Preparing players for live competition periods.
Travel Players are scheduled to compete in 1 tournament in the Fall and 5 tournaments in the Spring. Tournaments are located in Edmonton and Calgary. Each family is responsible for the cost of traveling for their child. Travel cost will vary based on distance of travel and length of stay.
Program Cost: \$950 cost include player uniform and club registration to all elite team events.

The Elite program involves the athlete competing in a very competitive tournaments involving other basketball teams from various regions in the province in Edmonton and Calgary. This competitions avails the athlete to access their performance and areas that they need to improve upon. It also gives them the opportunity to socialize among their peers from across the province.
Within the sport year, the athlete participates in 6 such tournaments in Edmonton and Calgary.
