I, Brooke Lacey was a competitive hockey player in the Fort McMurray Minor Hockey system and upon graduation from minor hockey I started participating in snowboarding at Vista Ridge. During my grade 12 year in high school I shifted from competing competively in girls hockey at the Alberta Provincial Championships to entering the Arctic Winter Games Qualifications where I was chosen as an alternate athlete.

In my university years I started to develop a competitive level of snowboarding as a member of the Sun Peaks Mountain community. In 2018 I joined the Sun Peaks Volunteer Ski Patrol, where I was encouraged to try out for Team Canada in the 2019 Winter Universiade Games. I met the qualifications to compete by submitting a list of my accomplished tricks, skills and experience. After my application I was invited to be a member of the 12 person Alpine Snowboard team to represent Canada at the Krasnoyarsk Winter Universiade games. I was the single Canadian representative for the Slopestyle division. In the competition I had the opportunity to compete against some of the best female snowboarders from France, China, Netherlands, Germany, Russia & other European nations.
