The Fort McMurray Fury U17B is a team of competitive soccer players from Fort McMurray who are part of the Fury youth soccer program. This group of boys has played together for many years and has had great success in tournaments in this province.

They and their families are so committed to their participation in soccer that the team stayed together during the evacuation in 2016 and fulfilled their commitment to participate in the Edmonton Minor Soccer League. They were Provincial Futsal Champions in 2014, placed fourth at the 2016-17 Indoor Tier 2 Provincial Championships and were the Silver medalists at the 2017 Outdoor Tier 2 Provincial Championships and the Bronze medalists at the 2018 Outdoor Tier 2 Provincial Championships. With some assistance from the RMWB through the Games Legacy Grant in 2018 the same group of boys were the Silver Medalists at the Super Cup in Manchester, England. This is a great accomplishment for our team given that they must compete with the top teams from Edmonton and Calgary in at the Provincial Championships, and competed against teams at a very high level in Sweden and England.

To compete at the Indoor Provincial Championships 2019 which is the subject of this Grant Application, the team had to play at least 6 games against teams of a similar or higher caliber. As there are only enough players in Fort McMurray for ONE team at this level of competitiveness, these games took place during team travel to 3 different tournaments in the 2018-2019 indoor season.

The team won Gold at the Spruce Grove Early Bird Tournament (Spruce Grove), took the Silver medal at the FC Memorial Tournament (Edmonton, February 1-3, 2019), and placed 4th at the Slush Cup (Edmonton) March 1-3). At the Indoor Provincial Championships in Okotoks the boys defeated Xtreme FC from Edmonton in the 5/6 game after a tough draw in the round robin portion of the playoffs.

The team travelled by Diversified bus to compete in the Indoor Championships. This is a normally a very significant expense but we were able to reduce it considerably as we shared a bus with an older group of players who competed in Calgary the same weekend, and also had the assistance of employer grants for bussing due to volunteer work by two parents on our team. The amount for bussing included in this grant application is the remainder that was paid by the team.

This still left the team with significant expenses which form the subject of this application.

The team remains together for another indoor season which will require continued travel to a minimum of two out-of-town tournaments PLUS indoor provincials. While we make every effort to keep expenses to a minimum by having families drive for most tournaments in the Edmonton area, this is still a significant burden for families with players involved in this sport. Accomodation expenses for the upcoming season are budgeted to be \$7000.00 plus any bussing.

The team was the grateful recipient of a Games Legacy Grant in mid 2018 for a development trip to Europe, and therefore did not feel it was appropriate to apply for a subsequent grant during last year's cycle. We hope you will favourably consider this application.

The players on this team have benefitted greatly from their continued involvement in sport and take seriously their responsibility to represent Fort McMurray on the provincial stage.
