I will also gladly be challenged as a percussionist to perform with instruments I am familiarizing myself with. The variety of genres in the music we are preparing as a Symphony will update my technical abilities. This experience will also teach me independence in practicing my music because of the expectations and short-term rehearsals set by the program. Rehearsing with a new ensemble of equally talented and trained musicians would invigorate my passion for music and introduce me to the music community on a provincial level.

Overall, my participation in the Alberta Wind Symphony will expose me to a more formal music training to equip myself for the coming years in music performance.
