- The new MDP will respond to Wood Buffalo's changing social, cultural, and economic conditions.
- The MDP sets out the vision and blueprint for how growth and development will happen in Wood Buffalo.
- The MDP provides a comprehensive land use policy framework that outlines a strategic path to manage growth across the region.
