# DELEGATIONS:Mr. Jerry Metz, representing Markaz Ul-Islan, St. John the<br/>Baptist Catholic Church, McMurray Gospel Assembly and<br/>Northern Lights Health Region re: Land for Future Development

Mr. Metz was in attendance to speak to an information package which had previously been distributed to Council Members about the need to secure land for two churches, a mosque and long-term care facility. The group has come together, as service providers to the community for families and the aging population. The combined groups have 3,000-4,000 residents using their facilities from Friday to Sunday, and the present facilities are inadequate to meet the demands of the rapidly expanding community.

Mr. Metz indicated that the group has been working together since 2001 in a quest for land and has put together a comprehensive proactive plan which will address the community's needs. Mr. Metz provided an overview of the proposed development, noting that the parcel identified in the Real Martin West Area Structure Plan is the only suitable location. Mr. Metz concluded his presentation by requesting that Council commit to not pursuing further development of the subject property for any purpose other than church development and a seniors facility. Mr. Metz also requested Council's support of the group's request that additional serviced land be set aside for future church and health facility development.

In response to questions from Council, Mr. Metz, along with Ms. Lorraine Demers, confirmed that other religious affiliations were involved in discussions regarding the acquisition of land. Should any of the existing properties become available, those groups within the Ministerial Association would have first opportunity to purchase. Mr. Metz also confirmed that it is unknown if the existing facilities would be closed or sold upon acquisition and development of new facilities, largely due to the growth taking place within the community.

The following Motion was presented by Councillor Chadi:

"MOVED by Councillor Chadi that the presentation from the McMurray Gospel Assembly, St. John the Baptist Church, Markaz Ul-Islam and Northern Lights Health Region be received as information, and referred to Administration for preparation of a comprehensive report for Council's consideration."

It was suggested that a definitive timeline should be established, as the group is waiting for an answer and costs are continuing to escalate.
