## 5.1. Wildfire Mitigation Strategy FireSmart Wood Buffalo

THAT the updated Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo Wildfire Mitigation Strategy (2022-2027) (Attachment 1) be approved for use as a guiding document for FireSmart in the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo; and

THAT the Mayor be authorized on behalf of Council to provide a letter of support for the Forest Resource Improvement Association of Alberta, in support of the Regional Emergency Services, FireSmart Wood Buffalo team application for vegetation / fuel management funding.

## 6. Councillors' Motions

#### 6.1. Creation of Alberta Provincial Police Service - Councillor K. McGrath

WHEREAS the Wood Buffalo region and the Province of Alberta are rebuilding from the impact of significant economic stressors over the past six years; and

WHEREAS the region has enjoyed exemplary service from the RCMP as Alberta's police service of choice; and

WHEREAS crime rates are improved over the long-term through improving community access to mental health and addictions support services and through justice system reform, not through policing; and

WHEREAS in the spirit of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls to Action Report, police and justice system reform MUST be implemented with the full consultation of our Indigenous communities and Peoples;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo joins the 96 municipalities and stakeholder groups in a call to action to the Government of Alberta regarding the creation of an Alberta Provincial Police Service.

### 6.2. Rural Water and Wastewater Utility Billings - Councillor S. Wigle

WHEREAS the Municipality's Rural Water and Sewer Servicing Program is open for residents in some rural communities to connect and some residents have now connected to the Municipality's piped water and sewer services; and

WHEREAS some residents have seen an increase in their water and wastewater utility billing since the time of connection; and

WHEREAS water and wastewater utility billing rates should be reviewed for all rural areas to ensure fairness and consistency;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Administration conduct an analysis of water and wastewater utility billings in the rural areas and bring forward this information during the discussion on the User, Fees, Rates and Charges for 2023.

6.3. Fiscal Responsibility Policy FIN-160 - Councillor K. Ball

THAT Administration review and bring forward recommendations to amend the Fiscal Responsibility Policy FIN-160 to ensure that appropriate capital budget amendments are brought forward for Council approval.

6.4. Elected Officials Compensation Review - Councillor K. Cardinal

THAT Administration be directed to undertake a third-party review of the Elected Officials Compensation, Travel and Expense Policy LEG-050 and bring forward proposed changes to the Policy as well as remuneration recommendations for the 2025 Council in Q3 of 2023.
