Summary:

The Community Impact Grant provides funding to registered non-profit organizations that meet community needs and contribute toward the strategic priorities identified by the Municipality through the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo 2018 - 2021 Strategic Plan. The Community Impact Grant encourages organizations to submit applications that support one or more of three streams: Community Events, New Events, and Community Programs and Projects (Attachment 1). For the Community Programs and Projects stream, 48 applications (Attachments 3 - 50) were submitted by the close of the Call for Applications, and of those, 30 met the funding criteria and are recommended to Council for funding approval (Attachment 2).

The initiatives that are eligible for the provincial Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) have been identified, and those eligible expenses will be funded through that provincial funding partnership (\$300,000).

Background:

On August 12, 2019 a Call for Applications for the Community Impact Grant was posted on the Municipal website, shared on social media, and circulated via email to past grant applicants. Information sessions were also held throughout the Municipality from August 15 to September 11, 2019. The Call for Applications closed at 4:30PM on September 23, 2019.

For the Community Impact Program (three streams), a total of 81 applications were received by the posted deadline, with requests totaling \$4,202,729. The applications were reviewed by Administration, and screened for compliance with the Community Investment Program Policy FIN-220 and the Community Impact Grant Guidelines. Twenty-seven applications did not meet the eligibility criteria and are not recommended to receive a Community Impact Grant in 2020.

Budget/Financial Implications:

The recommendations for funding included community programs and projects throughout the region. The total approved allocation will be included in the 2020 Community Investment Program operating budget.

Rationale for Recommendation:

The Community Impact Grant provides municipal financial support to non-profit organizations to deliver programs, services and events that have a positive impact on the residents of Wood Buffalo.
