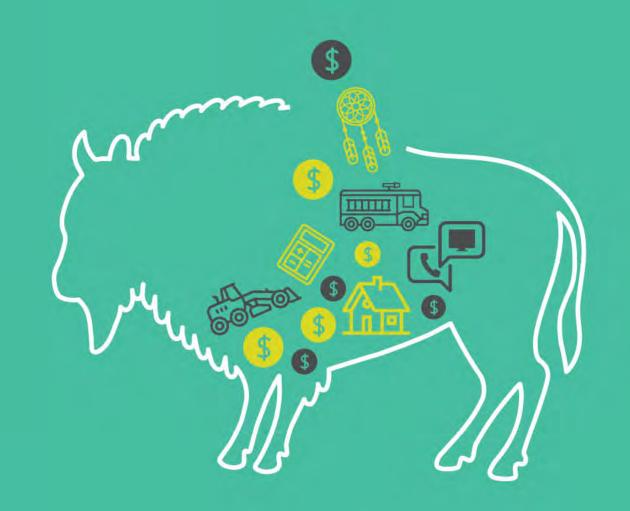

Description:	The province now has a two-way radio communications system known as the Alberta First Responders Radio Communications System. The RMWB can make use of AFRRCS at no charge until 2030 and the CAO has signed the access agreement recently. Bylaw has been informed that RCMP and RES plan to migrate to the new system and should work in collaboration to come onboard as well. Migrating to AFRRCS is also in line with KPMG's Lessons Learned/2016 Horse River Wildfire Report Recommendations and OH&S mandate.
