HAUL PERMIT

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made this 16th day of May, 2011

The expected duration, time and date shall be included.
(Should a company/contractor require an extension to the hours/days, a written authorization from the Municipality may be obtained if circumstances for the request deem it necessary)

Location of Haul: Within the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo limits, including Highway 63.

Route: As outlined on the map attached as "Appendix C"

THIS PERMIT IS ISSUED IN COMPLIANCE WITH BY-LAW 02/079 AND/OR ANY OTHER BY-LAW REPLACING THIS BY-LAW, WHEREAS THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE TO BE ADHERED TO:

1. PERMITTEE of this Haul Permit shall be responsible, where required, for daily cleaning of the approved route; the roads are to be maintained daily to ensure they are up to Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo standards. This includes removal of all tracking/debris from the roadways. In the case of default by the Permittee in carrying out this provision, the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo may give notice thereof to the Permittee. If the Permittee fails to commence to remedy such default within fifteen (15) days after receipt of such notice, the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo shall take such steps as required to remedy the default. The Permittee shall be liable for any and all reasonable costs and expenses incurred by the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo, including all attributable overhead and administrative costs,

within thirty (30) business days from presentation of an invoice by the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo to the Permittee.

2. PERMITTEE of this Haul Permit shall be responsible for daily Dust Control as per an acceptable Dust Control Management Plan, attached as "Appendix A" which will include:

- a) Location and Length of dust control stretches;
- b) Type of dust control product to be used;
- c) Plan for the maintenance of the dust control stretches;
- d) Schedule for checking the effectiveness of the dust control; and
- e) Plan for management of the dust control stretch after the haul is complete.

3. PERMITTEE of this Haul Permit shall be responsible for all cost incurred by the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo for the repairs to curbstops, valves, hydrants, sidewalks, curbs, pavement and/or gravel surface of route, landscaping and any other such appurtenances to highways resulting from the haul made pursuant to any permits issued under this By-Law.

4. The Permittee shall also be required to provide the Municipality a Road Maintenance Plan, as attached as "Appendix B" which is to include:

- a) The type of maintenance the contractor will provide for gravel roads; and
- b) the type of maintenance the contractor will provide for paved roads.

5. PERMITTEE of this Haul Permit shall ensure that posted maximum speed limits are observed along the entirety of the pre-approved route.

6. PERMITTEE of this Haul Permit shall ensure that no vehicle is loaded beyond its legal load limit and all trucks will tarp loads.

7. PERMITTEE of this Haul Permit shall ensure all company/contractor vehicles have proper insurance and registration; all trucks shall have unit numbers and contact phone numbers legible to vehicles meeting or passing the truck; all drivers under the control of the company/contractor shall be advised of the conditions insofar as the driving obligations.

8. PERMITTEE of this Haul Permit acknowledges and is aware the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo reserves the right to REVOKE, CANCEL, or POSTPONE any permit issued under the authority of this section, without notice, where weather and other conditions warrant.

9. Notwithstanding the above stated rules, the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo shall reserve the right to change, delete, or add to the document as circumstances dictate.


10. In consideration for the granting of the approval herein contained, the Permittee shall pay to the Grantor concurrent with the execution of this Agreement a one time payment in the amount of \$200.00, plus a 5% administration fee and GST for the Grantor's legal, administration, and disbursements in connection with the negotiation and execution of this agreement. Invoice to Permittee will follow.

Non-compliance of the above conditions will result in a penalty and revoking of the Haul Permit.

APPENDIX "A"

DUST CONTROL PLAN

A minimum of twice daily the dust control sections will be reviewed and maintained to ensure the dust control is up to Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo standards.

- a) Location and Length of dust control stretches

From Bulyea Avenue to 128 Garden Lane

- b) Type of dust control product to be used: WATER

- c) Plan for maintenance of the dust control stretches

DUNVEGAN GARDENS will clean/water as needed or at a maximum of twice per day.

- d) Schedule for checking for the effectiveness of the dust control and reporting of same. Checklists MUST be sent in no later than NOON ON FRIDAY.

- e) Plan for management of the dust control stretch after the haul is complete.

All dust/debris will be removed from the street at the contractors' expense, if the work is not done to RMWB standards and is cleaned by RMWB staff, *DUNVEGAN GARDENS* will be charged for this service.

APPENDIX "B"

ROAD MAINTENANCE PLAN

All roads are to be maintained to ensure they are up to Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo standards. This includes removal of all tracking/debris from the roadways.

Type of maintenance provided for gravel roads:

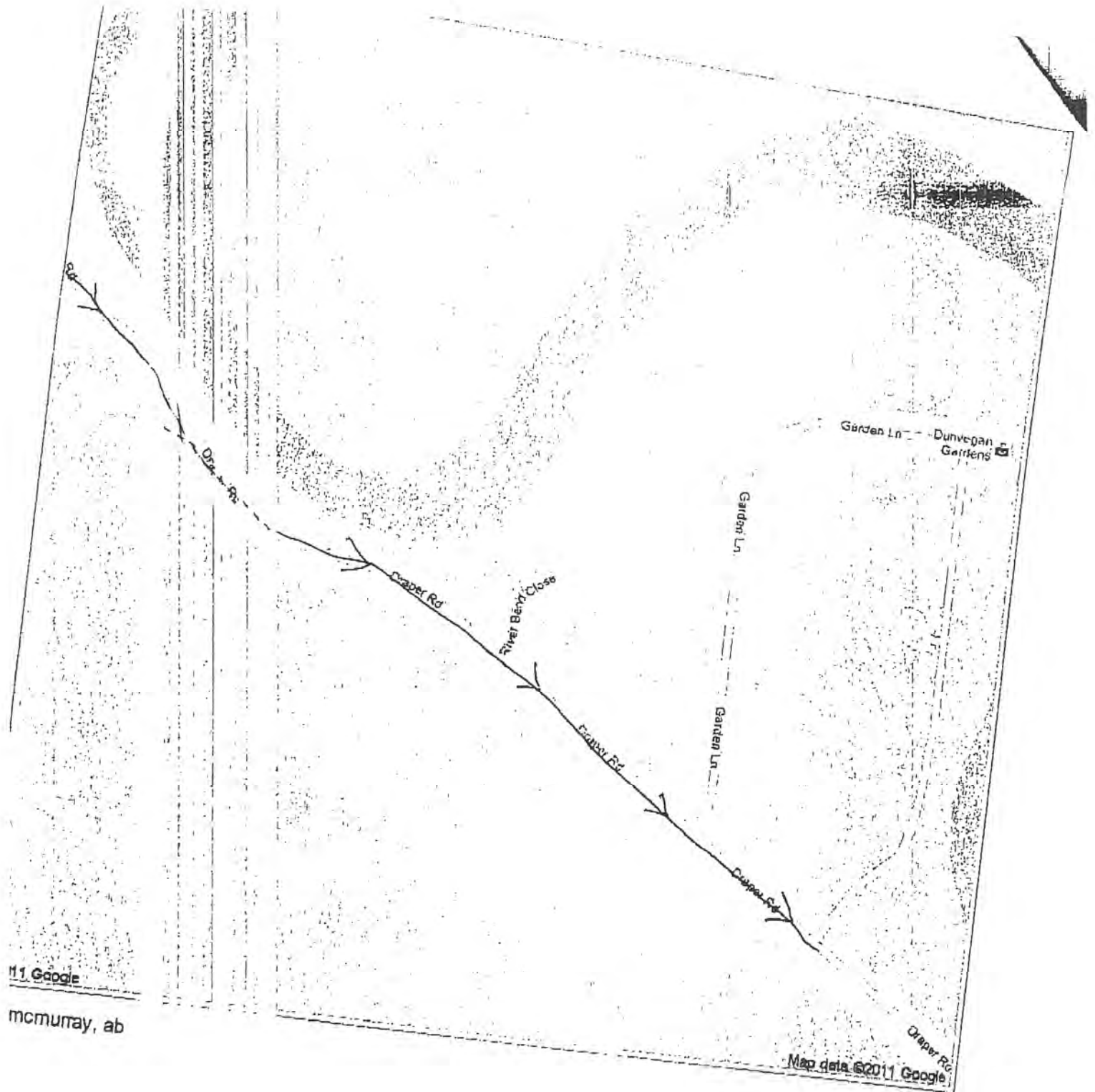
Water or grade road after 100 to 200 loads and , refrain from hauling during heavy rain.

Type of maintenance provided for paved roads:

Drivers to ensure that no debris or dirt is on the exterior of the haul truck prior to leaving demolition area. Any debris on route is to be reported immediately to site supervisor for clean up. An end of workday review will be done of the route to ensure there is not debris or dirt that will impair motorists.





This permit is subject to the conditions outlined herein and all other municipal, provincial and federal legislation and regulations. This permit may be cancelled or suspended without notice at the sole discretion of the MUNICIPALITY. All appendices attached to the permit form part of the permit.

Hauling is NOT PERMITTED under this Haul Permit for the purpose of using the property at 128 Garden Lane, Fort McMurray as a place for disposal or stockpiling of any material or thing, or in support of any other activity or development for which there is no valid and subsisting development permit.
Permitted Haul Route:	Hauling from various locations to 128 Garden Lane, Fort McMurray (the "Haul Location") as outlined in the map attached as Appendix "C"
Authorized Use(s) at Haul Location:	Sale of hauled material at Market Garden at 128 Garden Lane, Fort McMurray.



Haul Permit Conditions

- 1) This Haul Permit only allows hauling that is consistent with uses authorized by way of a development permit for the Haul Location. Any hauling that the MUNICIPALITY, in its sole discretion, deems inconsistent or incompatible with the lawful uses of the Haul Location may result in this permit being cancelled or suspended and may result in other enforcement measures, including but not limited to a stop order.
- 2) The PERMITTEE shall provide for daily dust control and mud tracking pursuant to the municipally approved Dust Control and Mud Tracking Management Plan attached as Appendix "A" which shall outline the following:
 - a. roadways for which the PERMITTEE is responsible for dust control and mud tracking;
 - b. type of dust control product to be used;
 - c. type of mud tracking control to be used;
 - d. plan for the maintenance of the dust control and mud tracking;
 - e. PERMITTEE reporting requirements;
 - f. any other requirements the municipality deems necessary.
- 3) The PERMITTEE shall provide for road maintenance pursuant to the municipally approved Road Maintenance Plan attached as Appendix "B" which shall outline the type of maintenance for gravel roads and paved roads, as required.
- 4) Should the PERMITTEE fail to comply with any provision of the Dust Control and Mud Tracking Management Plan or the Road Maintenance Plan, the Municipality may give notice thereof to the PERMITTEE. If the PERMITTEE fails to remedy the default within 24 hours of receipt of the notice, the MUNICIPALITY may undertake any steps reasonably necessary to remedy the default and may charge all costs and expenses incurred by the MUNICIPALITY, including any overhead and administrative costs, to the PERMITTEE. The PERMITTEE shall be liable for any and all of the aforementioned costs and expenses within 15 days of receipt of the invoice from the MUNICIPALITY. Failure to pay such invoice may result in the permit being cancelled or suspended and other enforcement action, including but not limited to an action to recover costs and expenses.
- 5) Should the hauling activities permitted under this permit result in or cause damage to any of the following, the PERMITTEE shall be liable for the costs and expenses, including any overhead or administrative costs, reasonably incurred by the MUNICIPALITY to remedy or repair the damage: curb stops, valves, hydrants, sidewalks, curbs, pavement, landscaping, bridges, approaches, crossings, guardrails, signs, light fixtures, utility fixtures or any other such appurtenances to highways or any related infrastructure that attaches to, enables, or supports these appurtenances. The MUNICIPALITY may invoice the costs and expenses to the PERMITTEE who shall remit payment within 30 days of receipt of the invoice. Failure to pay such invoice may result in the permit being cancelled or suspended and other enforcement action, including but not limited to an action to recover costs and expenses.

- 6) The PERMITTEE shall ensure that the permitted haul vehicles drive at least 15 kilometers/hour below the posted speed limit on the following roadways:
 - a. Draper Road and
 - b. Garden Lane.
- 7) The PERMITTEE will ensure that none of the permitted haul vehicles is loaded beyond its legal load limit and all vehicles will tarp or otherwise cover any loose loads.
- 8) The PERMITTEE will ensure all permitted haul vehicles have proper insurance and registration for operation in Alberta. All vehicles must have a unit number and contact phone number legible on the vehicle to passing vehicles.
- 9) The MUNICIPALITY may, at its sole discretion, cancel or suspend a permit without notice and in so doing may consider factors including, but not limited to: weather, environmental hazards, overall volume of vehicular traffic, nuisance caused by haul vehicles, and the condition of the roads over which hauling occurs.
- 10) The MUNICIPALITY reserves the right to change, delete, add or amend the provisions of this permit as deemed necessary in its sole discretion.
- 11) This permit is limited to the restrictions and conditions herein and any non-compliance with this permit may result the permit being cancelled or suspended, and other enforcement action including but not limited to an action for the recovery of costs.

APPENDIX "A"

Dust Control and Mud Tracking Management Plan

The purpose of this plan is to minimize any dirt, soil, mud, gravel, sand, clay, lime, fertilizer, manure, or other substance or material of any nature or kind whatsoever to become loose, detached, blown, drop, spill or fall on from any part of any permitted haul vehicle onto any highway, roadway or land indicated on the haul route during the haul. The PERMITTEE is required to control dust and manage mud tracking as outlined on the roadways listed (the "Roadways").

Roadway(s):	From 128 Garden Lane to the beginning of Draper Road
Type of dust control product to be used:	Water
Type of mud tracking control to be used:	Daily sweeping of the Roadway
Maintenance plan:	Watering and sweeping the Roadway twice a day

Road Maintenance Plan

All roadways are to be maintained to the engineering standards of the MUNICIPALITY.

Gravel Roads:	Grade as required to maintain or exceed municipal standards.
Paved Roads:	The PERMITTEE is responsible for ensuring any dirt or debris that may fall, drop or blow off any permitted haul vehicle is immediately reported and removed.

- a) Location and Length of dust control and mud tracking stretches;
- b) Type of dust control product to be used;
- c) Type of mud tracking control to be used;
- d) Plan for the maintenance of the dust control and mud tracking stretches;
- e) Schedule for checking the effectiveness of the dust control and mud tracking; and
- f) Plan for management of the dust control and mud tracking stretch after the haul is complete.
- g) Tarps are required on all loads.

4. Invoice to Permittee will follow.

14. Copy of haul permit must be available for viewing in every vehicle.

Non-compliance of the above conditions will result in a penalty and revoking of the Haul Permit.
