## Distinguished Service AWARDS

The purpose of this award is to recognize elected officials of Alberta urban municipalities who have served 20 or more years in an Alberta municipality.

Criteria	To be nominated for the award, an elected official must have at least 20 years of service on an Alberta municipal council.
Nominating Process	A Council may nominate a peer for the Distinguished Service Award by completing the nomination form.
	The Municipal Secretary or City Clerk is to confirm the start date of the period of service by completing the appropriate section of the award nomination form.
	The award nomination form shall be supported by biographical information on the nominee's contribution to the community.
Award Committee	The award committee is AUMA's Executive Committee. After approval, recipients will be notified of their selection.
Type of Award	The award will be a certificate, plaque or other form of suitable recognition.
Time of Award	The Distinguished Service Award shall be presented during the Annual Convention.
