


Census 2018: Highlights


- 100% enumeration rate

- Average household size increased from 2.95 to 3.01 people per household
- People aged 30-34 remains the largest age cohort.




Census 2018: Population by Type of Residency











Census 2018: Shadow Population











Census 2018: Urban Area Population




Census 2018: Rural Communities Population











Census 2018: Dwelling Type


