




18. What is the community need that the event will address?

This Competition would be beneficial in the community because there has not been a Local Amateur Martial Arts Competition in the Wood Buffalo community since 2002 for Taekwondo and Brazilian Jujitsu. Having this event and allowing local support would be beneficial to the community as well the youth involved in Mixed Martial Arts.

19. How was the need determined?

Majority tournaments available to attend most often are outside the local area and involve having 450 members from one Club traveling on Highway 63 in order to attend. Tournaments usually are during the Winter months which can decrease the ability to attend as it is weather permitted. Traveling on Highway 63 during the Winter months is dangerous and illogical. Many of the youth involved in Mixed Martial Arts are unable to attend non local tournaments due to the long distance needed to travel, however in providing a local tournament we are able to ensure all of our youth in Mixed Martial Arts are able to attend.

We will be able to have local support as well as more spectators during the event. More Mixed Martial Arts youth will be able to be involved without having to travel a great distance in order to attend.

21. What will be the positive impacts to the community?

The positive impacts within the community will be the following:

-Supporting a Local Organization.

The event will produce income for local businesses in the area of Fort McMurray, such as hotel accommodations, local restaurants, as well as allowing non-locals to see our beautiful community.
