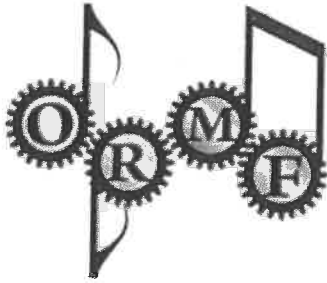

Jane Gibson, of [REDACTED] 17(1) Fort McMurray, and accompanied on the piano by Mrs. Mindy Su performed in the 44th Oilsands Rotary Music Festival in Fort McMurray in March, April and May. Jane performed six contrasting classical (not movie, television or popular) Vocal selections, and two Musical Theatre (one Ballad and one Up-Tempo, maximum allowed) making her eligible to be recommended to the Alberta Provincial Music Festival in Edmonton in May. Adjudicator Ms Cara McLeod of Edmonton recommended Jane for Girls Vocal Solo 16 & under, and Mr. Kelly Handerek of Vancouver recommended Jane in Musical Theatre Ballad Solo 16 & under to the Provincial Festival.

Jane travelled there in May to compete in Musical Theatre Ballad Solo 16 & under on Wednesday, May 29th and in Girls Vocal Solo 16 & under (two selections) on Friday May 31st, in the Provincial Festival. Jane was awarded a Superior rating in her Vocal Solo and Distinction in her Musical Theatre Solo. We are very proud of her accomplishments!
