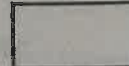

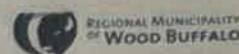

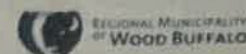

Cross Country Alberta is hosting a provincial on snow training camp where athletes from across the province get group and individual coaching from top coaches from across the province. The on snow camp is open for Midget to Junior ages - from ages 10 -19 both male and female skiers.

It is an opportunity to get on skis earlier in preparation for the upcoming season. The Camp starts 1:30pm on the Friday afternoon and finishes at 1. The Ptarmigan Nordic skiers and coaches will need to travel on the Thursday.

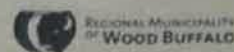
Activities include on-snow technique, games and relays, video analysis, workshops and evening sessions.

Camp Cost \$200 per participant which includes cross country ski coaching, two nights accommodation at Lake Louise Hostel, meals and special guest presentation.

Ptarmigan Nordic is planning to take 10-12 athletes and 2-3 coaches for this camp.

It is to prepare our athletes for the Zone 7 qualifier for Alberta Winter Games which will be held in December. As well as continue to grow and develop our local athletes in preparation for the Arctic Winter Games in 2022. Ptarmigan Nordic is working on developing a strong base of local athletes to represent our community.

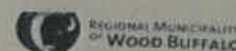
