As President of the Fort McMurray Chess Club, I am extremely pleased to be able to recommend Sophia Aldaco Murayama for the 2019 and 2020 Games Legacy Grant. She is a great player with a lot of potential to do well on the national chess scene. I have known Sophia since September 2018 when she first joined the chess club. I have had the opportunity to see her excel at the game in a very short span of time. Since she learned to play chess, she has been fascinated by the intricate game and showed a high motivation to learn more and more. She presents with exceptional problem-solving skills for a person of her age.

The Fort McMurray Chess Club is dedicated to providing training and development initiatives to chess players by means of introducing them to the deeper aspects of the game. We allow the players to learn at their own pace, always emphasizing that they should always enjoy the sheer fun that this activity has to offer. Sophia loves the game and is convincing her friends to also join the club. proved himself very capable as an excellent player who just loves chess. She is very passionate about the game and has spent hours of her time at home doing chess puzzles, playing chess and attending chess lessons. She does well with self-study too.

More recently, in the provincial tournament (2019 Alberta Youth Chess Championship: Qualifier tournament) that took place here in Fort McMurray in April 20 and 21, 2019, she came in third and was also the top girl player in her age group. This result qualified her to go and play in Canadian Youth Chess Championship that was held in Regina in July 6 -10, 2019.

Her excitement and enthusiasm paid off when she achieved second place in the girls U8 division. Her family incurred great costs to take her to this tournament.

At our annual awards ceremony, Sophia was also named the most improved player of the year. This is based not only on her exceptional progress made, but also her ability to think on her feet and to consider each move carefully before executing it. This is just awesome to see how a small child like Sophia can achieve the patience and bouncing around in her blue and yellow team colours.

With her excellent performance in Regina, Sophia is poised to also do well in the 2020 chess tournaments. She will be representing FMCC, the RMWB and, if she goes to nationals again, the Alberta region. We were very fortunate to have Sophia as part of the Fort McMurray Chess Club as a young player. She is outstanding at chess with exceptional tactics and analytical skills and she is no longer discouraged when she loses a game. She knows she can learn from her failures and that is a most wonderful life skill. I am sure she will benefit tremendously from your support.
