In order to qualify for Provincials a choir must perform a minimum of two contrasting musical pieces with at least one piece be sung in two parts. We performed 4 pieces with two being sung in 2 parts. The choral adjudicator recommended us to represent Fort McMurray at Choral Provincials in Edmonton on May 30/2019. We competed against 10 other choirs that represented communities all over Alberta. We were awarded a mark of 94 and came in 1st at Provincials. This was a huge highlight (Never done in Fort McMurray) in my Musical Career.

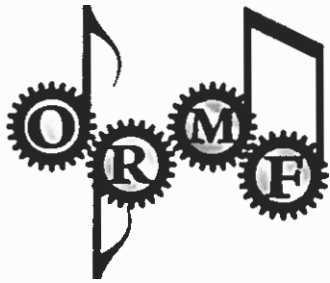

St. Anne Grade 4 to 6 Choir members, under the direction of Mrs. Cathy Larson, and accompanied on the piano by Mrs. Mindy Su and on the cello by Mrs. Lydian Van Thiele, also performed in the 44<sup>th</sup> Oilsands Rotary Music Festival in Fort McMurray in April. They performed three contrasting classical (not movie, television or popular) choral music selections, making them eligible to be recommended to the Alberta Provincial Music Festival in Edmonton in May. Adjudicator Miss Erin Craig of Edmonton awarded them the highest mark in Gr. 4 to 6 Choral Singing in our festival and recommended them to the Provincial Festival. They travelled there in May and received First Place in the Provincial Festival. Although we have had choirs in the Provincial Music Festival for many years, this is the first time any of them have ever placed first. We are very proud of this accomplishment!

The Oilsands Rotary Music Festival, a member festival of the Alberta Music Festival Association, is jointly sponsored by The Fort McMurray Society of the Friends of Music and the Fort McMurray Oilsands Rotary Club.
