Hanet has played football in the Fort McMurray youth football association(s) since he was in grade 3, or PeeWee age. He has played with the following organizations:

- PeeWee football under various team names (Knights, Crusaders, Dinos)

During his PeeWee years, he was awarded the league MVP award in Defense.

He has been invited to try out for Team Alberta for the past two consecutive years. While in U16 age group, he made it past the first set of try-outs and advanced to the final selection.

During 2018/9 year he was selected to represent Team Alberta as a Defensive Back in the Pacific Challenge in Hawaii. Selection is completed province wide and is narrowed down to approximately 40 players from across the province.

Two qualifying events are held in Alberta each spring: an initial selection camp in Edmonton in January and a final selection camp in Calgary in April. Players compete by position against the best players in those positions from across the province.

Football Alberta provided a lump sum cost to parents of players attending the selection camps , a mini-Camp in Red Deer, and for U17 Team Alberta who travelled to the Pacific Challenge in Hawaii.

The total cost was \$3000 and this is shown above in the "Hotel" section but it is for both flights and the hotel in Hawaii and also covered some of the mini-camp costs. There was no breakdown of flights versus accommodations provided. However, I am attaching their email to this application. Parents paid the total cost in \$500 increments. Transportation to/from the selection camps, mini-camps, and Edmonton airport are not included in the \$3000.

Travel:

- 1) Red Deer mini-camp: parents transported players to/from Red Deer at their own cost
- 2) Pacific Challenge: Football Alberta used Westjet airlines to fly the team from the Edmonton airport. Parents transported their players to/from Edmonton airport at their own expense.

Accommodations:

- 1) During the Red Deer mini-camp players stayed in a high school gym
- 2) During the Pacific Challenge the players stayed at the Maui Banyan resort with 3 players sharing a unit. The players were responsible for preparing two of their own three meals daily.

Please note that both the **U18 Team** and **U17 Team** will have a **Mini-Camp on June 14-16 in Red Deer** and progress to their respective events. The **Football Canada Cup for the U18 team will be from July 3-13** in Kingston, ON while the **U17 team** will depart from **Edmonton to Hawaii** for the **Pacific Challenge from August 4-12 in Maui, HI (those dates are still tentative at this time)**. Also note that the U17 is structured to cater mostly to the athletes born in 2003, however a few 2002's may be selected to the U17 team for further development of their football skills even though this would be the last year in this program. Do not sign up for this program unless you are committed to be chosen to either team. We just let go close to 300 players who would gladly take your place in a heartbeat so please make sure you are committed to this process before continuing.

A payment schedule has been designed to limit the burden on the cost of participation breaking it up into **\$500 installments** each month that will end based on what team the player is chosen to. Payments will start upon your registration in January and continue each first of the month starting March 1 until completion. For those making the **U18 team** it will cost **\$2,000** in total and the \$500 payments will stop after May 1. For those chosen to the **U17 team** payment will continue for **two months after that for a total of \$3,000** (US dollar and international travel the reasons for the increased cost). **If you are released from the Top 100 at any time during the process you will be refunded in full. See below for how to go back on-line to register for this. Have your Access Code handy.**

Players Responsibilities

The players selected to the teams will have the following responsibilities that they should read and be comfortable with prior to proceeding. They will have to click their understanding of these on the on-line registration form they will have to complete at the end of this email.

- 1) I understand it will be my responsibility to secure and bring all appropriate equipment (including mouth guard) from my current team. If my current team is not cooperative then it will be my responsibility to make other arrangements.
- 2) I understand all the equipment I bring will be checked for safety and if rejected will be my responsibility to replace.
- 3) I will be present at all meetings and on-field sessions of all above listed events associated with this event. Any prospect of my missing a meeting or on-field session must be cleared with the Head Coach.
- 4) If selected I will meet the following requirements for participation which means:
 - I will abide by any guidelines as listed by the Head Coach
 - I will inform the Athletic Therapist of any injuries/illness that happen to me.
 - I will ensure that I am well behaved and follow the schedule
 - I will not use any alcoholic beverages, cannabis, illegal drugs, or tobacco products at any time
- 5) I will be prepared for each on-field session and follow the practice plan set by the Head Coach
- 6) I will answer the bell each day at the appropriate time and place for any on-field session or special event as listed in the schedule.
- 7) I will not create disruptions in teams activities for my own purposes and keep a clean academic and behavior record at my school while listed as a member of this team.
- 8) I understand that any deviation from the above requirements may lead to my being dismissed from the team at the coaches/General Managers discretion without any prospect of recovering my registration fee.
- 10) I will accept the decisions of the coaches with grace, character and respect as it pertains to my further involvement.

What you Need prior to Registering and Paying

You will need the following items prior to registering below:

- **Passport** – We will need to know your **Passport number, Expiry Date and Name as it Appears on the Passport**. For the **U18 program** it will be used as the ID required to participate and must be presented and verified on-site in order to play in the Football Canada Cup. Note: International Passports (i.e. United States, Jamaica, etc.) will be acceptable as long as the bearer has a Permanent Residence Card for Canada as well. For the **U17 team** it will be required for International Travel. **If you do not have a current Passport you only need indicate that on the on-line registration where it asks and fill in when you think you will be receiving it.**
- **PayPal Account** – When it comes to the payment schedule you will have to register your PayPal Account in the on-line registration. If you do not currently have one they are easy to get. However **if the payment plan or other issues are a problem** please contact Sally in the office at [\(780\)427-8108](tel:7804278108) prior to registering to sort out other options.
