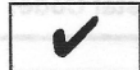

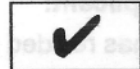

She is an RCM Advanced Specialist and Examiner and Piano, Piano Literature and Performance Wellness Instructor from the McEwan University Conservatory of Music Alberta College Campus. She offered Jerry online lessons, but because of how the characteristics of learning piano is, we have to also have in-person lessons in Edmonton per her request. we had lessons on Jan18th, Mar15th, April18th and May17th. In order to save accommodation fees, most of time we only do one day trips to Edmonton and back, so we only have books, food and gas expenses.

This must be performed in costume with movement and the use of specific stage props. Adjudicator Mr. Kelly Handerek of Vancouver, awarded Jerry the highest mark in Musical Theatre Ballad 12 & under and recommended him to Alberta Provincial Festival in Edmonton. Jerry received a Distinction standing for his performance, which means a mark in the range of 85 to 89%.

We are very proud of Jerry's accomplishments as there are 35 Alberta Music Festival Association member festivals who have the privilege of sending competitors to the Provincial Festival.
