I attended Emily Carr College of Art & Design for four years, graduating in 1990. I have studied various art forms, as well as curating and exhibiting, through continuing education in British Columbia, Ontario, and Alberta throughout the years since.

I have actively exhibited my artwork across Canada and United States since 2007. My artwork is showcased at Points North Gallery in Fort McMurray, AB, and I am part of the permanent roster of artists featured at Alberta Branded, the gallery store in the Legislative Assembly Visitor Centre in Edmonton, AB.

To exhibit at the Art Vancouver International Art Fair, artists must complete an application process which includes submitting a Curriculum Vitae demonstrating a history of professional exhibitions, an artist's statement about the work that will be featured in the exhibit, five professional photographs of work created within the past two years, and pay a \$565 application fee. That application is reviewed by adjudicators with the Visual Art Vancouver Foundation and unsuccessful applicants are given a partial refund of the submitted fee. As a successful applicant, I will now pay the remaining application fee of \$3,412.50, and arrange for shipping and insurance of my artwork. I am applying for assistance with travel costs in order to support my attendance and participation in this event.

Having the ability to showcase my work in Vancouver, in a setting such as is being provided by Art Vancouver, will be invaluable to my practice. It will allow for exposure of my artwork in a thriving market, and connect me to other professional artists and arts administrators. It is challenging to have high-level learning opportunities in Fort McMurray due to the lack of arts instruction and infrastructure. Peer-to-peer discussion, professional critiques of artwork, and other learning opportunities are critical to growth and success. I have also applied to take part in the Artist Speaker Panel at the event providing an opportunity to showcase my work and our region.

Art Vancouver has been running since 2015 and sees over 10,000 visitors from international and national destinations. They provide marketing and PR support, a professional display area in the Vancouver Convention Centre, and connections to galleries, buyers, and other artists. Although not a traditional gallery space, the setting is professional with stringent display standards and artists are selected by juried application.
