This allows talented players to accumulate high-quality training hours on par with leading European nations and begin to develop world-class attributes in the four corners of development.

Alberta Soccer Association Technical Staff with support from the Canadian Soccer Association Regional EXCEL Talent Manager have recently completed a comprehensive scouting process in Alberta. You will see below an outline on the steps that was taken to guide our decision making to select players into the Alberta Regional EXCEL Program:

- Alberta REX & Club program scouting by ASA Technical Staff
