## **Project Description and Scope**

The Grouse Bridge and Raven Bridge within the Birchwood Trails are failing and need to be rehabilitated. The bridge structures have shifted and are no longer suitable to carry users or maintenance equipment. The bridges will need to be rehabilitated meaning this portion of trail will be closed for the duration of the construction. There will be no negative impact on the environment as this bridge is located at an already developed site. The RFP for replacement will was issued in 2020 and the project works have been designed and tendered. The tendered works had only one bidder and the bid was in excess of the currently available budget. A Capital Amendment has been requested for a proposed increase of \$300,000 to cover the full cost of construction. The estimated completion date is October 2021. Permits from Department of Fisheries and Oceans will be required, but are easily obtained, as this will be a clear span bridge that follows DFO guidelines.
