However, with the renovations currently happening there, the family is requesting that the new boat launch be renamed Bernard Jean Boat Launch due to the fact there are so many residents now with the surname "Jean". Bernard was born in London, Ont. on Jan 3, 1926. He served in the Canadian Army and then later moved to Westbank, BC where he took up a Veteran's Land Act farm. Bernard came to McMurray with his family in 1967 to work at GCOS. In 1968 they opened a gift and stationery store on Franklin Avenue and in 1970 started a weekly newspaper, <i>The McMurray Courier</i>. The gift and stationery store and the print shop were well patronized businesses until they closed in 2002. Bernard and Frances and family delighted to explore the rivers of northern Alberta and were keenly interested in the region's history. Through <i>The Courier</i>, the monthly <i>Focus magazine</i> and Frances' book <i>More than Oil</i>, the family recorded much of the history of the area.</p> <p>The entire family have been active in the community. For many years Bernard was director of the Baptist summer camp at Gregoire Lake and taught Sunday School at the church. He was an avid gardener and experimented with many trees and plants for our climate.</p> <p>He died in 2004, the same year Brian, his youngest son was elected as a Member of Parliament. In 2015 Brian is Leader of the Official Opposition in Alberta.</p>
