Demolition Permit Application Process

Step 1

Applicant makes submission

Step 2

- RMWB checks submission for completeness
- RMWB requests further information if necessary

Step 3

RMWB reviews application

Step 4

RMWB renders decision and notifies applicant

Demolition Permit Requirements

- 1. Site Plan
- 2. Route Haul Plan
- 3. Schedule
- 4. Stockpiling Plan
- 5. Certificate of Title
- 6. Site Clean Up Plan
- 7. Utilities Management Plan
- 8. Fees
- 9. Certificate of Recognition

Demolition Order

- All properties damaged by the wildfire will be issued a Demolition Order
- The Order ensures that properties are demolished and cleaned up in a timely fashion
- If properties are not cleaned up in a reasonable time frame, the Order provides authority to the Municipality to enter onto the property and take the necessary actions to complete clean up

Demolition Permit Application Commitments

 Administration will continue to strive to meet the 48-hour turnaround time on complete applications
