- 2. Make clear that landscaping services, or sale of landscaping materials in bulk, must not be carried out on or supported from the subject lands;
- 3. Place significant restrictions on the times that bulk deliveries of plants or other goods for retail sale, may be made to the subject lands;
- 4. Ensure that any keeping of animals on the subject lands other than licensed domestic pets will be conditional upon appropriate safeguards for human health and the well-being of the environment, including without limitation written confirmation from appropriate provincial regulatory bodies that proposed keeping of animals will not pose a material risk to human health or the environment.
- 5. Require an Applicant for development approval to provide evidence that the water system meets provincial regulation or standards and that the drinking water is safe for human consumption
- 6. Allow existing uses on the subject land that are compatible with the essentially residential character of the area, to continue, including but not limited to, market garden, beekeeping, trampoline park, greenhouse.

AND FURTHER MOVED that the target date of June 26, 2018 for first reading of the aforesaid Land Use Bylaw amendment is subject to the full cooperation of the

owners and/or managers of Dunvegan Gardens, and their representatives, in meeting with and communicating with Administration as frequently and in as much depth as required to identify and deal with all relevant issues and concerns and to enable Administration to bring forward the requested Land Use amending bylaw on that date.
