#### 7.3. Support Request from Sturgeon County

THAT the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo participate in the 2020 Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) Conference Advocacy Event; THAT up to \$10,000 be approved from Council's 2020 Public Relations Budget to fund the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo's contribution to the 2020 FCM Conference Advocacy Event; and

#### 7.4. Advocacy Initiative - Teck Frontier Oil Sands Mine Project

THAT the Mayor be authorized to send a letter to all members of the Federal Government Cabinet requesting that the Teck Frontier Mine project be approved and outline the benefits of the project to our region; and

THAT Mayor Don Scott, Councillor Krista Balsom, Councillor Keith McGrath, Councillor Jeff Peddle and Councillor Verna Murphy be approved, on behalf of Council, to travel to Ottawa to petition the Federal Government for final approval of the Teck Frontier Mine Project and that all costs associated with the travel, including accommodations, meals and per diems, be accommodated in Council's 2020 Business Travel Budget.

# 7.5. Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP) Exemption with Lac La Biche County

THAT the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo and Lac La Biche County, be exempt from completing an Intermunicipal Development Plan as required under Section 631(1) of the Municipal Government Act for the lands lying along the common boundaries of the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo and Lac La Biche County.

THAT Administration continue discussions with Lac La Biche County on the creation of an Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework Agreement Bylaw.

7.6. Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework (ICF) with Improvement District No. 349

THAT the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework between the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo and ID No. 349, as outlined in Attachment 1, be approved; and

THAT Administration be directed to notify the Minister of Municipal Affairs before April 1, 2020, that the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework with ID No. 349 has been completed in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*, Section 708.33 (4).
