6. Councillors' Motions

6.1. Eid-al-Adha (Feast of Sacrifice) - Councillor F. Banjoko

WHEREAS Eid-al-Adha, also known as the "Feast of Sacrifice", is one of the largest holidays celebrated in Islam; and

WHEREAS Eid-al-Adha is typically marked by charity, communal prayers, large social gatherings with family and friends, slaughtering of livestock and providing meat to the needy and sharing it with family; and

WHEREAS the Muslim population in Fort McMurray is four times the National average (currently at 12% of the population, with Toronto being at 8.9%) with the Municipality focusing to continually improve inclusivity for residents; and

WHEREAS the 2023 Feast of Sacrifice is Thursday, June 29, 2023.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Administration be directed to investigate and provide a report to Council by April 14, 2023, on the possibility of providing a covered space for 15 days each year to allow the Muslim community the opportunity to participate in the Feast of Sacrifice.
