THAT a Special Council Meeting be held at 4:00 p.m. on February 19, 2019 at the Anzac Recreation Centre.

**Summary:**

The Anzac Recreation and Social Society (ARSS), would like to formally request that the presentation regarding the Anzac Community Hall third-party assessment be moved to February 19, 2019.

It was intended that the society report back to council 90 days from the October 20, 2018 council meeting, which would mean that a presentation would be required on January 22, 2019. The report has yet to be finalized and (ARSS) is dedicating time to prepare the community for Winter-fest and a National Sled Dog race event.

The Anzac Recreation and Social Society has also requested that the meeting be held at the Anzac Recreation Centre to engage as many of the residents as possible from the community.

**Background:**

Construction began on January 11, 2018 and following the demolition of interior wall sheathing in the Rink Hall, black mould was discovered. The area was sealed with plastic to isolate the mould to prevent further contamination in the building. A full assessment of the building was completed by Stantec in May 2018, and based on the assessment, it was determined that the renovations would not go forward, and that Administration would look to determine further options.

Administration met with the Community and key stakeholders including the Anzac Recreation and Social Society on multiple occasions. It was indicated at these meetings that the preference is for the Community to continue to have a community hall that is distinct and separate from the Anzac Recreation Centre, which will complement

activities undertaken at the center, but not compete directly with it.

October 20, 2018, Council passed a motion that Administration be directed to facilitate with the community, a third-party assessment, paid for by the community, by a contractor approved by the Municipality and report back to Council within 90 days. It was mentioned that if feasible, the meeting at which the report is brought forward be held in Anzac.
