PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS Human Rights Day is observed every year on December 10th as a

commemoration of the day on which, in 1948, the United Nations General

Assembly adopted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights; and

WHEREAS in 1950, the Assembly passed resolution 423 (V), inviting all States and

interested organizations to observe December 10th of each year as Human

Rights Day; and

WHEREAS the human rights principles are enshrined in the Candian Immigration and

Refugee Protection Act of 2001 which grants the full protection and maximum social, cultural and economic benefits to immigration and

refugees; and

WHEREAS these principles acknowledge that discrimination targets individuals and

groups that are vulnerable to attack: the disabled, women and girls, the poor, refugees, immigrants, minorities, and all those who are perceived as different. However, these victims of discrimination are not alone; and

WHEREAS individuals, institutions and social profits come together to recommit to

the principle that, all persons are equal in dignity, rights and

responsibilities without regard to race, religious beliefs, colour, gender

identity, physical disability, age, ancestry, place of origin, sexual

orientation or otherwise.

THEREFORE NOW, I, Don Scott, Mayor of the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo, do hereby proclaim December 12, 2017:

"Human Rights Day: Our Rights, Our Freedoms"
