The Fort McMurray Thunder Volleyball Club is a not-for-profit minor volleyball club that serves youths from ages 10 to 19. We are registered as part of the Volleyball Alberta and Volleyball Canada organizations. Our club has travel teams that compete in the Volleyball Alberta and Volleyball Canada sanctioned tournaments. Teams are made up of the best young athletes in our city under specific age groups.

This upcoming season, our 16U Girls Team will be traveling to Edmonton to compete at Nationals. The 108 of the best teams in Canada will be gathering in Edmonton for this fantastic tournament. Our 16U Girls team has been playing for the past three years and will be competing in this event where they hope to win a Div 2 National Championship.

The tournament itself has a \$1150 registration fee, plus travel expenses such as hotel and bus. The tournament will cost the team roughly \$5500. The season itself without the Nationals expense will cost the team \$20,000. Receiving a grant to help cover the expenses for Nationals would go a long way for our athletes and their families.
