Gymnastics is an exceptionally expensive sport to pursue and the commitment these girls make is like a part time job of upwards to 30 hours a week. Being in Fort McMurray these expenses are compounded with the extra travel, accommodations and coaching requirements to name a few among several other extra considerations that come in to play being located hours from a major center.

Fort McMurray's Gymnastics club, Norfort, has brought multiple major events to the Fort McMurray area in the last five years and all these events have been phenomenally successful. The events were so well met by visitors and the gymnastics community as a whole that our club continually receives requests to hold more upcoming annual events. The athletes that train and compete, especially at these higher levels, dedicate almost all free time to training, learning and competing. They do not have time for any part time jobs to supplement the costs. Parents are required to volunteer immense hours not only to help subsidize their children's fees but also to fund the day to day gym operations. Without the gracious grants, sponsorships, and financial support of institutions like yourselves Norfort would sincerely struggle to maintain the highest standards that we set for our club and it's athletes through the year.

Norfort is proud to have 2 athletes achieve High Performance status this year. This is the first time our club and Fort McMurray has had any Artistic Gymnastic High Performance Athletes. We are hoping that Norfort will have more high level athletes in the future in years to come.

NOTE

She then sends an invoice for all fees and charges applicable for the one event to each club, hence the large amount that was paid. It's all placed on one invoice.
