

Draper Grant Program Update

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Draper – Grant Program

On March 9th Engineering provided an update to Council on Flood Mitigation and Community Resiliency Update – Draper. As part of that presentation, we were to survey the properties in Draper.

We have received the survey results and will now do our analysis and sort the results into the following categories (categories previously presented March 9th):

Grant Program Update - Categories

The three categories were as follows:

1. Residence well above 250.9 m – confirm location and elevation of foundation drain (if applicable).
2. Residence near or slightly below 250.9 m – interior surveyor access needed to determine main floor elevation; consider site grading.

Grant Program Update - Categories

(continued)

3. Residence below 250.9 m – interior surveyor access required, contractor to determine feasibility of raising structure (is amount to be raised feasible? Can that type/condition of structure be raised?).

Next Steps

Once the survey data analysis is complete, we will address each individual lot owners with next steps:

- For those in categories 2 or 3 additional surveys will be needed to confirm main floor elevations.
- For category 2, consultants will be engaged to prepare grading plans; it is anticipated that lot grading will be done through a grant program as well.

Next Steps

(continued)

- For category 3, lot-by-lot assessments are needed to determine feasibility of raising structures.

Initial findings of these assessments (such as rough cost estimates and feasibility) will be presented before developing the grant program.
