**Summary:**

The attached presentation is before Council to provide information and outline the consultation process undertaken by Municipal/RCMP/Bylaw Services administration in the establishment of the RCMP Annual Performance Plan (Policing Priorities) and the outcome of the 2014 Citizens Survey as well as the results of the 2014-2015 Annual Performance Plan.

**Background:**

The RCMP is a progressive, transparent and proactive organization which believes in working in partnership with the communities it serves. One way the RCMP accomplishes this is by completing an Annual Performance Plan (APP) establishing policing priorities.

Annually, by April 1<sup>st</sup>, each Detachment Commander must solicit input from their local residents, stakeholders, community leaders and organizations to capture the needs, concerns and issues of their communities. This was completed this year through consultation with the various communities in the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo and with staff. While priorities such as traffic and youth are common, it is recognized that each community has unique needs. As priorities can change rapidly, this information is used to ensure that policing services are meeting the demands of the citizens.
