

**BYLAW NO. 15/023**

**A BYLAW OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF WOOD BUFFALO TO AMEND THE LAND PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE BYLAW**

**WHEREAS** the *Municipal Government Act* provides that a council may pass bylaws in relation to the establishment and functions of Council Committees, and may amend such bylaws;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo has passed Bylaw No. 15/020 to establish a Land Planning and Development Advisory Committee, and now wishes to amend that bylaw;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo, in open council assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 15/020, the Land Planning and Development Advisory Committee Bylaw, is amended by:
  - a) deleting the existing text from Section 3.1(b) and substituting therefor “one member from the Northeastern Alberta Aboriginal Business Association (NAABA)”;
  - b) adding the following as Section 3.2: “If it is not possible to appoint a member from each group identified in subsections (a) through (f) of Section 3.1 the Council may, at its discretion, appoint one or more additional public-at-large members under subsection 3.1(g) in order to ensure a Committee composition of eleven members.”; and
  - c) adding the following as Section 3.3: “The primary residences of all Committee members must be within the boundaries of the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo.”
2. This bylaw comes into force when it is passed.
