Chow, Wayne: Longtime resident and businessman in the community. Operated a restaurant in the Oil Sands Hotel for a number of years (1959-65) before opening the New Town's first Dry Cleaners and Laundry. He also opened the first Jewelry Store in the Community. Wayne was active in community work being a Charter Member of the Kiwanis Club. He operated the Dry Cleaners and Laundry for approximately nine years before opening the Chow's Confectionery. He sold his business when he retired. He has donated money to MacDonald Island and also purchased a fountain for the water reservoir for the golf course. The fountain can be found in MacDonald Island in the summer.
